



## Responsibility

- It is NOT your responsibility to prevent your sexual assault.
- It IS your responsibility to not sexually assault people.

#### Consent

verb (used without object)

to permit, approve, or agree; comply or yield (often followed by to or an infinitive): He consented to the proposal. We asked her permission, and she consented.

#### Consent

- Prior Consent
- Continuous Consent
- Consent after the fact

#### Prior Consent

- Consenting before en event occurs.
- A Contract
- Is not enough by itself in BDSM

#### Continuous Consent

- Consent should exist for the entire duration.
- Can be withdrawn at any time.
- U.S. Constitution 13th Amendment

#### Informed Consent

- Knowledge and understanding of exactly what you are consenting to.
- This is often used as a legal term in medical consent.

# BDSM examples of informed consent?

#### Post Consent

 Often the reason for our current Domestic Violence Laws.

## Implied Consent

- Consent inferred by a persons actions.
- Sometimes by their silence or lack of protest.

#### Revocation of Consent

- **■** NO!!!!
- Safewords
- Leaving the Relationship
- Revocation is always legal
- Ignoring revocation is always a crime!!!

#### Collateral Consent

- Bystanders
- Other partners
- Families



#### Seductions

- Seeking consent can be sexy
- Shows you care
- Exposing your own vulnerability is hot.


#### Consensual Non-Consent

- Prior agreement to the illusion of non-consent
- D/s play
- Rape Play
- Master/Slave
- etc



#### When Someone Asks

- "NO" is a complete sentence
- "No, thank you" is better
- If you mean "yes", say yes clearly
- If you hear a "No" respect it



#### When Consent Breaks

- How big a break?
- Repairing Consent/Trust



# Complete Apology

- Say you are sorry
- List the things you did to harm them
- Say you are sorry
- Show empathy for the harm
- Clarify the cause of your actions
- Ask for forgiveness
- Describe your lesson
- List your correction
- Say you are sorry
